

ENTRY RULES

1. Entrants must be under 35 on 1 January 2023.
2. Entrants must be a member of the Fellowship for British Hairdressing and remain a member throughout the period of being on the F.A.M.E. Team.
3. Entrants must be a fully qualified hairdresser.
4. Membership of the F.A.M.E Team allows members opportunity to present themselves as individuals. The Fellowship endeavours to co-credit Team members' salons, but the focus of activity will always be placed on the individuals relationship with the Fellowship, the F.A.M.E. Team and its members.
5. The F.A.M.E. Team are expected to work together as a cohesive, creative and artistic unit. We encourage a spirit of Team unity. This is a chance to work with talented contemporaries and senior Fellowship members; to strive, be original, to learn and develop a creative identity within the hairdressing scene.
6. Membership of the F.A.M.E. Team is a serious commitment and will require individuals and/or their salon to support F.A.M.E. Team activities throughout the year. The Fellowship for British Hairdressing's financial resources are carefully controlled and restricted and we should inform you it is in our experience that being part of the F.A.M.E. Team can cost the individual/salon a significant amount for travel, accommodation and model costs, plus time out of the salon.
7. We will issue an invoice for £2,000 towards the Fellowship's costs at the time of the winners announcement. Full payment will be required by 31 January 2023.
8. Only one person from any one salon can apply.
9. The members of the F.A.M.E. Team 2023 will be announced at the Fellowship for British Hairdressing Luncheon & Awards Event in December 2022.
10. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Team members will be expected to undertake reasonable promotional activities throughout 2023 and may use the F.A.M.E. Team title as appropriate and directed throughout the year.
12. The F.A.M.E. Team Leader reserves the right to suspend or remove any member of the F.A.M.E. Team as a disciplinary measure if they break any of the rules or if a member is deemed to have brought The Fellowship into disrepute. All F.A.M.E Team Members are expected to be impartial regarding product used.
13. The F.A.M.E. Team cannot form a branded unit for a period of one year.
